8 Injured In Manhattan Fire

Cause Of Blaze Under Investigation

NEW YORK — Eight people were injured, two critically, in a fire that swept through a Manhattan I

The blaze broke out just before 5:30 a.m. on the third floor of a six-story residential building in the fire spread to the fourth floor, he said.
