Rich kid unleashes vile tirade at Uber driver



The son of a wealthy US property magnate is facing a police probe after hurling an abusive, anti-gay tirade at an Uber driver after he cancelled his booking.

Jake Croman's foul-mouthed rant was filmed by driver Artur Zawada as he sat inside his car outside the University of Michigan while Croman and a group of his friends crowded around the vehicle, the NY Daily News reports.

"They don't give a s--- about you, they don't give two f---s,"
Croman yells at the driver through the rolled up car window while filming with his own phone.

"There's 50 of you and there's one of me who spends the most money here you little f---.

"Yeah f--- you Artur you little f----f---. You want to kick me out, then kick me out you little piece of s---.... You little minimum wage f-----".

After appearing to walk away, Croman turns to face the driver, unleashing a fresh rant.

"You working all day? Well guess what? I'm going to go and sit on my ass and watch TV," Croman says.

Since Zawada posted the video rant to YouTube on March 23, it has been viewed more than 300,000 times.

He claims the video documents the fourth time he has been "harassed by this rider and his friends".

Zawada has since filed a complaint with Ann Arbor police over claims of verbal harassment.

In a statement released to US media, Croman claims his outburst was in response to Zawada making a number of "offensive anti-Semitic remarks".

"This video shows one side of an argument I had with an Uber driver two weeks ago after he refused to pick me up on the basis of my religion," the newspaper quotes Croman's statement as saying.

Croman is the son of Steven Croman, a property developer,

who's under investigation for allegations of forcing "rent stabilized tenants" out of their homes.
