Big 'get' for Dan

Dan Rather has snared an exclusive "60 Minutes II" interview with one or both of the Camden, N.J. parents accused of starving four of their adopted children, sources say. CBS isn't commenting, but it's believed that Rather will interview either Raymond Jackson Sr. and/or his wife, Vanessa, who are accused of starving the boys – Bruce, Tyrone, Keith and Michael, ages 9 to 19 years old. "60 Minutes II" is off this week, so the interview could air next week.

Raymond and Vanessa Jackson, who claim they are innocent, are currently out on bail.

Ch. 5's Mark Joyella, who's reported on countless fires, became part of the story Oct. 25 when a fire swept through his East 18th St. apartment building – a story covered by The Post (and headlined "Civilian Fire Hero" for Kevin Harley, who helped alert tenants to the blaze). The story included a photo showing Harley, and a melted air-conditioner on the floor above him – which was Joyella's air conditioner.

"The experience was chaotic and terrifying, and I firmly believe that if not for the FDNY, I would certainly have lost everything, possibly even my life," says Joyella. "Only New York's Bravest kept their cool and got all of us out safely . . . these guys gave clear, calm directions and firmly kept us moving."

Joyella lost a lot in the fire, "but it made me so proud to be a New Yorker," he says. "My neighbors went above and beyond, raising the alarm and looking out for each other in the chaos . . . and the FDNY showed all of us just who they are: The Bravest and The Best."

Ch. 2's Warner Wolf will emcee ex-Met Keith Hernandez's "Field of Dreams" benefit to raise money for the Alzheimer's Assisted Living Center at the Cobble Hill Health Center in Brooklyn.
